About Us:

Position Summary:

People International is seeking a passionate and visionary European Mobiliser to drive recruitment and mobilization across Europe, with a focus on reaching unengaged regions for Central Asia. Based in continental Europe, this role involves strategic leadership, building partnerships with churches and mission organizations, and establishing new mobilization centers in areas without existing offices. The Mobiliser will recruit long- and short-term workers, coordinate resources, and represent People International at various events. This support-based position is ideal for a self-motivated Christian leader with experience in mission mobilization and team management.

Key Responsibilities:

1. **Leadership and Visionary Oversight:**
 - Lead People International's expansion across Europe (excluding current office locations) with strategic vision and alignment to organizational standards.
 - Provide guidance for developing new mobilization hubs to ensure consistency in quality and adherence to People International's standards.
2. **Strategic Planning and Growth:**
 - Design and implement a Europe-wide mobilization strategy to support our mission, focusing on unengaged people groups (UPGs) in Central Asia.
